Team Spotlight | Utilities Operations Management Team

UC San Diego's Utilities Operations Management team is responsible for implementing the campus comprehensive automatic meter reading (AMR) strategy. AMR infrastructure allows for near real-time data acquisition and analysis. The team and campus partners use the data to confirm building performance compared to design expectations and historical benchmarks so the campus can address issues promptly and efficiently. The team also uses the data to track consumption and building operation costs. This multidisciplinary team is comprised of meter technicians, electricians, business systems

and utilities analysts, and engineering and administrative staff who together ensure the success of our initiatives.

Over the past decade, this team has installed and programmed more than 1,800 water, electric, gas, chilled water and high-temperature water meters, transitioning to 1,901 total building-level AMR meters. These efforts have led to the creation of our <u>Energy and Water Dashboards</u> which organize and clearly display all this information.

We want to remind everyone of the important role that you play in reducing energy and water use. Simple actions like maintaining your thermostat at 74 degrees, using energy-intensive equipment during non-peak hours, closing fume hood sashes when not in use, and reporting water leaks can make a significant difference.
