
Team Spotlight | Triton Transit

<u>Triton Transit</u> provides safe and reliable transportation for the UC San Diego community with fixed routes and smaller scale mobility services that operate seven days a week. Routes provide frequent connections to popular destinations on and around the main campus and nearby facilities, including grocery, retail and recreational destinations.

As one of few state employers certified to train, test and license commercial drivers, the team has employed and licensed hundreds of student commercial drivers with 125+ trained and 92 earning their commercial licenses since July 2023. Many former students have gone on to careers in the transit industry as bus drivers and trolley operators, including the current Director, Jose Perez, who began his career as a student driver in 2003 before returning in 2022.

Located in Parking Lot P703, the team's office provides a supportive space where students and career staff collaborate to improve service and the customer experience. Triton Transit thrives from the regular infusion of new student employees who bring their unique perspectives and energy to the team.

Fun Fact: Triton Transit held its first "Roadeo" on September 21, 2024—an event geared toward finding and celebrating its top commercial drivers. Raleigh Border was the driver with the safest and quickest time through the skills tests and earned the Triton Transit Bus Roadeo trophy and bragging rights for the year!
